We welcome creativity but some suggested projects will be vases, bowls, charcuterie boards and home decor items such as a soap dish or incense holder!

This intermediate ceramics class will focus on refining your skills in both handbuilding and surface design. Projects include hand-built template mugs or a square bowl, a lidded jar, and your choice of a cream and sugar set or a medium pitcher. We'll work with a range of tar paper templates, and each class will feature a new surface decoration technique, including craft foam stencils, water etching, mono printing and mishima to expand your creative toolbox. Ideal for students with some clay experience who want to refine their handbuilding skills and learn some fun new surface techniques.

#### Pottery Studio Memberships Include:

- Access to the pottery studio during nonclass time:
  - As a beginner member: during supervised open studio time
  - As an intermediate/advanced member: as a keyholder and/or volunteer supervisor
- Member Events: educational workshops & themed creative sessions
- A labelled shelf for your clay and your own tools and glazes
- Use of equipment and tools, after orientation and Studio Technician approval
- The ability to ask questions of our volunteer instructors/supervisors during open studio time
- Access to the pottery studio kilns for firing your work (as per the membership and kiln policies)

Pottery Memberships are subject to a trial period of three months and you must have previously taken a minimum of 20 hours of classes and/or be able to demonstrate basic knowledge of either hand building or wheel pottery, cleaning procedures, and have studio safety knowledge. Under certain circumstances, potters with advanced experience and/or instructors may be offered supervisor or key access under agreed-upon conditions. Key access is subject to a trial period and is subject to approval.

Pottery Memberships are not required to take most classes and workshops. Currently the Pottery Studio does not have a drop-in program.
